Camps are Monday through Friday; DROPOFF 8:30am, Pick-up 1:00 p.m.

Our camps are full of fun! Campers enjoy horse-back-riding, learning horse care & about horses in general. Our day camps aim to teach children (ages 5-15) about the wonderful world of horses. Camp will be held rain or shine. We have a lounge where campers can “hang out” and learn about horse care, their characteristics, breeds, colors, and safe handling on the ground and while mounted.

*We include H2O, fruit & sports drinks, snacks, Pizza on Fridays, ice pops, sno cones, Educational booklets etc. We do horse related activities all day long.

*We provide helmets and do not charge you to lease them. They are cleaned Daily.

We do not do a camp horse show as we feel it cuts into their maximum riding time. We’d rather let them ride longer and get more out of their 5th day lesson.

CHECK-IN:

Camp begins at 8:30 a.m. each day at the stables and ends promptly at 1:00 p.m. If you require “early drop off or late pick-up” (provided at \$10.00 per hour if we have more than 1 person needing such), please notify us at the time of registration and we will be happy to accommodate your schedule. If you are late for pick up, a late fee of \$10.00 will be charged. We only provide before and aftercare as needed, not daycare. Camp will be held rain or shine.

*Parents, please have the camper’s name in permanent marker on all belongings!

*Parents are not allowed to stay the entire camp day...SORRY! ☺

*Bring a lunch Monday through Thursday and have pizza with us on Fridays.

*We take plenty of pictures and videos that we share on our private page, JLB Stables Photography page. You may ask to join. You are welcome to stop by to take your own pics.

*Cellular phones are not allowed to be used during camp. Camper may bring them but they must stay in their bags in the lounge. We are not responsible for lost or broken items (phones).

REFUND POLICY

All deposits (\$100.00) are non-refundable. In case of injury or illness that causes the camper to leave camp early, the days missed will be pro-rated and half of the pro-rated amount will be refunded (minus the non-refundable deposit). All balances due on or before the first day of camp.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Pay in full: Pay in full before May 1st, 2017 and only pay \$400.00 per child. This is a \$50.00 discount. I will need completed documents and a check for \$400.00 to secure a spot for your child at this rate.**

Hold My Spot: Pay \$100.00 non-refundable deposit to secure a session for your child at the regular rate of \$425.00. Balance of \$325.00 is due upon the first day of camp by 8:30 am.**

I'll Take My Chances: Pay \$450.00 the first day of camp if any spots are available. I do not suggest taking your chances on this option.
